STARR

Sound Training Activities for Reading Readiness is designed for those children who are in Pre-school and Grade 1. The programme is completed over 10 - 12 sessions depending on the child's needs.

This programme has a greater concentration on sound training, and does not extend into spelling and reading. It is designed to prepare these children for reading and spelling, and to prevent, rather than overcome, some literacy difficulties.

STARS Basic

Sound Training Activities for Reading and Spelling - 'Basic' is designed for school-aged children. The programme is completed over 10 sessions. The primary concentration is firstly upon sound training, then work is done with regard to converting sounds into letters for reading and spelling.



STARS Intermediate

Sound Training Activities for Reading & Spelling - 'Intermediate' builds upon the skills learned in the STARS Basic Programme. The programme is completed over 8 sessions. It is designed to teach the children how to use the skills learned in the context of reading and spelling.

STARS Advanced

Sound Training Activities for Reading and Spelling - 'Advanced' is a more advanced programme for older students and adults who have completed the 'Basic' and 'Intermediate' programmes and require greater in-depth help in the areas of reading and spelling, rather than specific phonological awareness skills. The programme is completed over 6 sessions.
